CODE OF CONDUCT FOR MEMBERS- JUNIOR AND ADULT

The club believes that it is important that members, coaches and parents associated with the club should, at all times, show respect and understanding for the safety and welfare of others. Therefore, members are encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints they may have about any aspect of the club with Roger Crombleholme, Head Coach. As a member of the Midland Ski Club you are expected to abide by the following code of conduct:

1. All members must play within the accepted rules and respect officials and their decisions
2. All members must respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of gender, ability, cultural background or religion
3. Members should keep to original timings of training and competitions or inform their coach or assistant coach if they are going to be late
4. Members/skiers must wear suitable kit i.e. long sleeved tops, long trousers, gloves and helmet for training as agreed with the coach
5. Members must pay any fees for training or events promptly
6. Members in charge of Juniors, whether coaching ,officiating or just being responsible for them, are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind
7. Members are not allowed to smoke on training premises or whilst representing the club at competitions
8. Bullying of any sort will not be tolerated.
9. Members must not use any electronic device or social media that may or could bring the sport into any form of disrepute.
10. Members must have read, be aware of and abide by Snowsport England's Code of Conduct, Snowsafe and Equity policy statements.
